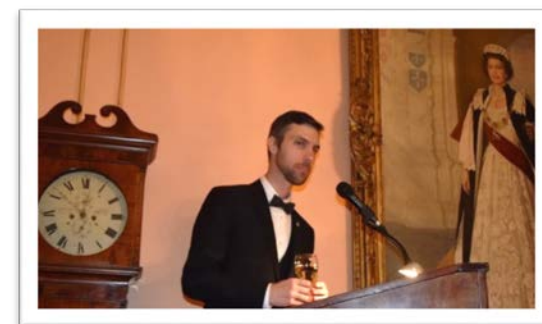
President's Reception at Government House

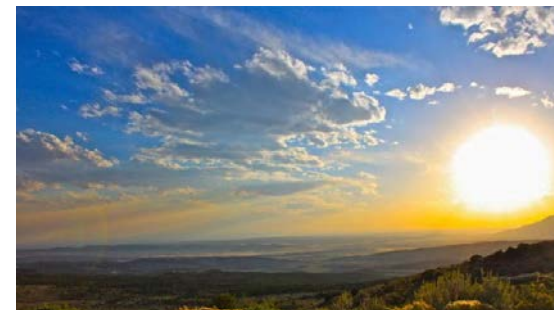
